### DAY 1 - TORONTO

Upon arrival at Toronto's Pearson International Airport, pickup your car and head to your hotel for check in.

### DAY 2 - TORONTO (NIAGARA FALLS) 130 KM

Today, take a leisurely day trip to Niagara Falls, the honeymoon capital of the world. Niagara is more than the spectacle of Niagara Falls; it's full of activities and attractions for everyone. We have included a Maid of the Mist cruise to the base of the falls for your enjoyment.

### DAY 3 - OTTAWA 397 KM

Travel to the Ottawa, Canada's capital city. The Ottawa region covers 4662 square kilometers and with its unique history, geography and lifestyle, it offers a wide variety of urban attractions.

### DAY 4 - OTTAWA

For thousands of years, the Algonquin nation used Victoria Island as a meeting place for gatherings, trading and celebrations. ### DAY 6 - MONTRÉAL

### DAY 7 - QUÉBEC 240 KM

Today travel to Québec, a port of call for every type of craft from pleasure boats to towering sea-going vessels. A stroll along the wharves in the Old Port near the Louise basin gives you a real feel for the majestic strength and gentleness of the river. Take the time to visit the Old Port of Québec Interpretation Centre for a fascinating survey of the timber trade and shipbuilding.

### DAY 8 - QUÉBEC

This is the only fortified city north of Mexico and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, so take the time today to walk the ramparts and explore this charming city.

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## **DAY 9 - RIMOUSKI 312 KM**

Today cross the St. Lawrence for the south shore and make your way east. End your day in Rimouski, a destination not to be missed, known as the oceanographic capital of Québec. As you travel from one end of the city of Rimouski to the other, your eye is inevitably drawn to the St. Lawrence River. Its unique setting in a natural amphitheater in the St. Lawrence River Valley gives it a special cachet, and you're sure to enjoy the salt air, the beautiful countryside and the warm Rimouski welcome. Overnight in Rimouski.

## **DAY 10 - STE-ANNE-DES-MONTS 179 KM**

A leisurely drive along the shoreline of the St. Lawrence River brings you into the Gaspésie today. Small villages and outposts abound. Stop at a lighthouse or two, as there are 15 dotting the coastline of the Gaspésie. At Matane, you will turn from the coast into the Parc National de la Gaspésie, and travel into the heart of the park for your overnight stay at the charming highland inn of Gîte du Mont-Albert. Overnight in Sainte-Anne-des-Monts.

## **DAY 11 - PERCE 200 KM**

Leaving the Parc National de la Gaspésie today, drive round the very tip of the peninsula taking time to stop at Forillon National Park, located at the mouth of the Gulf of the St. Lawrence. Perhaps you will see whales swimming close to shore for the bluffs in the park. A short drive brings you to Perce for the night. Overnight in Perce.

## **DAY 12 - BONAVENTURE 132 KM**

Take the time this morning to take a cruise out to the Rock and around Bonaventure Island and Rocher Perce Park, where you will see thousands of gannets and varied marine life. A short drive along the coastline of the Bay de Chaleur brings you to Bonaventure and your hotel for the evening. Overnight in Bonaventure.

## **DAY 13 - RIMOUSKI 317KM**

Today it is time to head back across the Gaspésie to the St. Lawrence River and Rimouski again for your overnight. Overnight in Rimouski.

## **DAY 14 - TADOUSSAC 129 KM**

A short drive and a ferry across the St. Lawrence brings you to Tadoussac. The oldest village in Canada. Today we have arranged for you take a whale-watching journey on the St. Lawrence and into the Saguenay Fjord. Overnight in Tadoussac.

## **DAY 15 - TROIS-RIVIÈRES 317 KM**

Today, continue downstream on the north shore to Trois-Rivières. Founded in 1634 by Lavolette, it is the second oldest city in Québec. Well before the arrival of the Europeans, the mouth of the three rivers was already an important hub of commercial activity for the Amerindians. Later the legendary Godefroy, Nicolet, Des Groseillers, Boucher and Radisson made Trois-Rivières the starting point of their explorations. It was also for many years the seat of one of the three governments of New France. Overnight in Trois-Rivieres.

## **DAY 16 - MONTRÉAL 137 KM**

Return to Montréal today to enjoy its fun atmosphere throughout the day and evening. Overnight in Montréal.

## **DAY 17 - TORONTO 554 KM**

Leaving Québec and Montréal today, travel back into the province of Ontario. Overnight in Toronto.

## **DAY 18 - DEPART**

It is time to depart from Toronto's Pearson International Airport, so don't forget to reconfirm your flight and departure terminal for check-in.
